Who is Flight-1 and what does Flight-1 do?

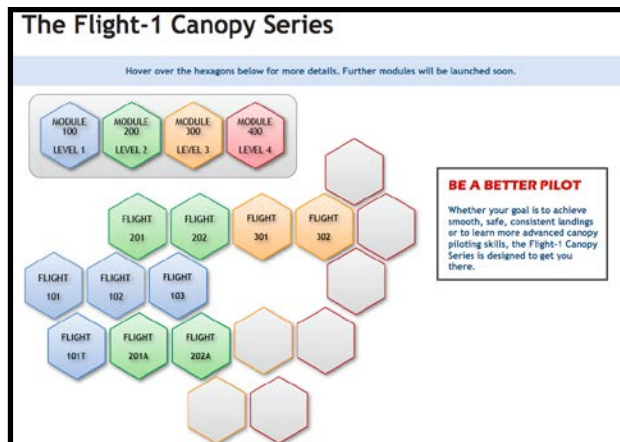

2. 100 Series Canopy Courses

The 100 series courses are for any skydiver with any experience level and provide the cornerstone for safety and survival skills under canopy, making you and your DZ safer for all skydivers.

100 Series



"Flying The Modern Wing" (101) deals specifically with creating good, soft, consistently accurate landings. You will fully understand the correct flare technique and develop the ability to debrief personal performance. The course defines the flight plan, ensuring a high degree of accuracy and safety. Finally, stalls and recovery techniques introduce controls to help understand the full performance range of the canopy.

Requirement:
Cleared to self-supervise (straight after AFF)



"The Canopy Performance Range" (102) takes you through a series of in-air exercises to explore the performance range of the canopy so that you can deal with emergency situations and difficult atmospheric conditions. You will be given more safety and survival tools, including controlled turns using different inputs, turn dynamics, dive recovery, and how to deal with a long spot.

Requirement:
Attended Flight 101



"Airmanship" (103) brings the skills you have developed into the general skydiving environment. The course explains how to manage the variety of skydivers on each jump and helps you understand the dropzone environment. It continues to develop your personal skills with advanced accuracy, showing how to adjust your glide slope in relation to the target.

B-License

3. 200 Series Canopy Courses

The 200 series courses are designed for a skydiver wanting to take their canopy skills to another level with high performance landings.

200 Series



"Developing Speed" (201) introduces the fundamental principles of high performance landings and speed-building approaches using pitch. The course also includes essential slow approach skills, and rear riser emergency landings.

Requirement:
- Attended Flight 101 & 102; OR
- Minimum of 200 jumps



"High Performance Turns" (202) will offer you a structured framework to building your high performance approach. It provides deeper information on building airspeed on approaches using rotation, and offers the chance to learn rules and altitudes associated with more challenging approaches. IT also offers flight planning and future training considerations.

Requirement:
- Minimum of 200 jumps
Recommended:
- Attended Flight 201
- 500 jumps

How much does the course cost?

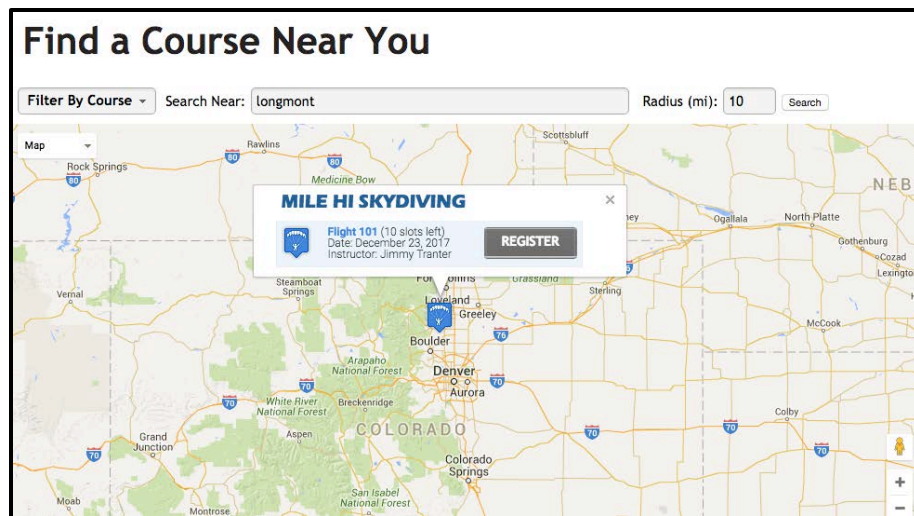
The cost of each course is \$150 plus the cost of 5 low altitude jumps (5,000ft hop n pops).

What happens if there is a weather day?

Our courses run rain or shine. The instructor will still deliver the course content and theory in the classroom setting. So - you might ask - **how do I complete the jumps?** If you don't get to make the jumps due to weather, you can show up to the same course at any dropzone within a year and make up the jumps for free, fully briefed and debriefed.
